

Sending Morse: Do's


- Adjust Key
- Develop Technique
- Practice



Sending Morse: Do's

- Dot : Dash Ratio = 1 : 3
- Spacing between Letters = 3 dits
- Spacing between words = 7 dits
 - = 2 Dahs with a dit space in-between





Sending Morse: Dont's

- Wrong Learning: Difficult to Undo & Re-learn
- Bad Code sending is painful 'Rythm' is the key!!
- May not convey the intended message
- Do not send faster than you can receive


