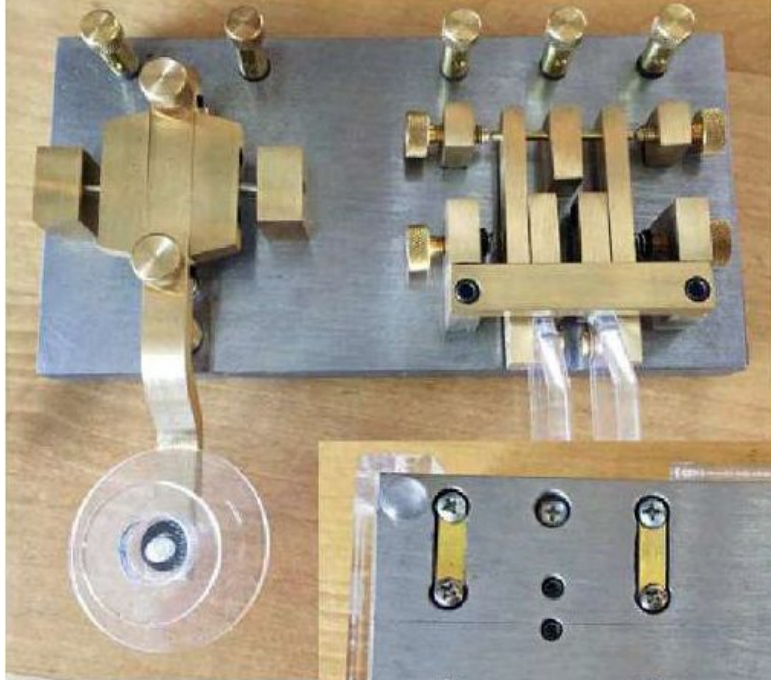

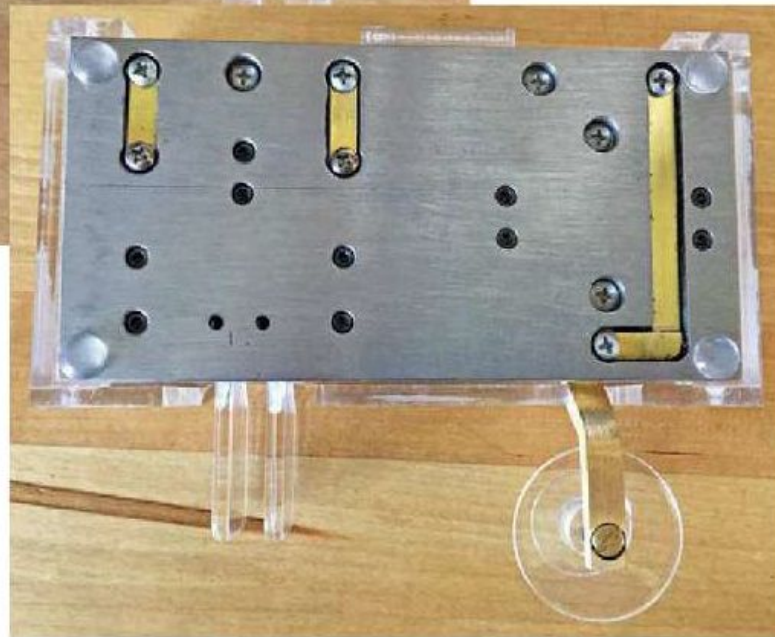
Compact, stable,

Sending Morse : Do's

- Adjust Key
- Develop Technique

Sending Morse : Do's

- Dot : Dash Ratio = 1 : 3
- Spacing between Letters = 3 dits
- Spacing between words = 7 dits
= 2 Dahs with a dit space in-between



Ham Radio - Learning Morse code, three things to avoid for better sending

Sending Morse : Dont's

- Wrong Learning : Difficult to Undo & Re-learn
- Bad Code sending is painful - 'Rythm' is the key!!
- May not convey the intended message
- Do not send faster than you can receive

- Take feedback to improve - listen to your own recording

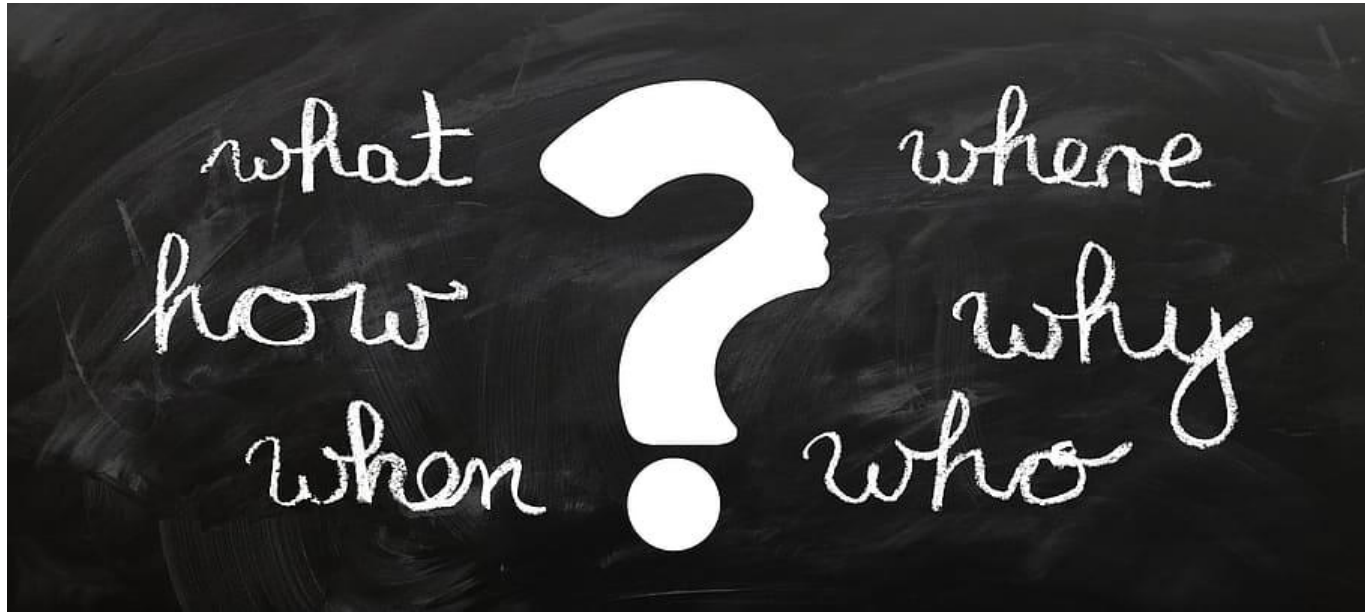
