CW QSO Format & Demo

Within the basic CW QSO format there is prominently “The Big Three”. These includes the RST, NAME, and QTH. These pieces of information form the basic beginnings of a rag chew CW QSO. For a contact to be “counted” in any context only the call signs and signal report are needed to be copied and received.

6. Break: Dah-di-di-dit dah di dah
